Sub: Technical Education – Admission of students to First Year B.E / B.Tech / B.Arch Degree Courses, Direct Second Year B.E / B.Tech / B.Arch Degree Courses, M.E / M.Tech / M.Arch Degree Courses, MBA and MCA, M.Sc²5 Years Integrated Courses and PGDBM / PGDBA Courses – 2018 – 2019 - Fee Structure in Self Financing Engineering Colleges – Fixation of Fee Committee recommendations – Collection of Annual and Semester Fee – Instructions to the Principals – Issued - Regarding.

In the G.O. first cited, the Government have issued orders for grant of Tuition fee waiver to First Generation Graduate students admitted to First Year B.E / B.Tech / B.Arch Degree Courses under Government quota through Single Window Counseling from the academic year 2010 – 2011 onwards.

Similarly in the G.O second cited, the Government have issued orders for grant of Tuition fee waiver to First Generation Graduate students admitted to Direct Second Year (Lateral Entry) B.E / B.Tech / B.Arch Degree Courses under Government quota through Single Window Counseling from the academic year 2010 – 2011 onwards.

For the students belonging to SC/SCA/ST/Adi-Dravida students converted to Christianity Communities who are eligible under the Centrally Assisted Adi-Dravida scholarship scheme, the revised G.O has been issued as cited in fourth reference.

The Committee on Fixation of Fee in respect of Self Financing Professional Colleges headed by Hon'ble Mr.Justice N.V.Balasubramanian under reference third cited has issued proceedings prescribing the annual fee for UG (B.E / B.Tech / B.Arch) Degree Courses and semester fee for PG (ME / M.Tech / M.Arch, MBA / MCA / M.Sc.-5 Years Integrated Courses and PGDBM / PGDBA) Degree Courses for the year 2017-2018 to 2019 – 2020 as follows:

In addition to the above fees, the Institutions have been permitted to collect the following fee as per the Proceedings of the fixation of fee in respect of self financing Professional Colleges:

1. The Institution is permitted to collect an amount of Rs.5,000/- per student as development fee.
2. The concerned Institutions are permitted to collect a refundable one time caution deposit not exceeding Rs.5,000/- per student at the time of admission to be refunded at the time the student leaving the Institution.
3. It is made clear that the fee fixed by the Committee is the maximum fee is to be charged by the Institution. It is open to the Institutions to charge lesser fee than the fee fixed by the Committee.
4. The Committee recommends to the Institutions to consider granting of partial waiver / concession of Rs.5,000/- per annum in case of deserving meritorious students.
5. The Committee directs the Institutions shall not collect or levy any other recurring or non-recurring fee including Capitation fee.
6. Any deviation of the orders of this Committee will entail serious penal consequences like withdrawal of approval by AICTE and disaffiliation by the concerned University as well as imposition of fine.

In this regard, the Principals of all Self Financing Engineering Colleges and Government Aided Engineering Colleges (Self Supporting Courses) are requested to follow the Government Orders cited in the reference and to collect only the prescribed fee fixed by the Committee headed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.V. Balasubramanian. Any deviation of the orders of this Committee will entail serious penal consequences like withdrawal of approval by AICTE and disaffiliation by the concerned University as well as imposition of fine. A copy of the Government Orders and Proceedings cited in the reference is enclosed herewith for your reference.
